HABITS AND HABITATS:-



A hardy evergreen perennial herb, which is usually found in the temperate region of the world. Native to the Himalayan region and distributed to the temperate region of Arunacha Pradesh.

PLANTS DESCRIPTION :-

Coptis is a hardy, evergreen blog plant and a small stem herb plant. Leaves are compound and glabrous. Flower are small, white in colour, regular. Fruits are small, many seeds follicles and seed are black. The roods are rhizomatous.

PARTS USED :-

Entire plants, especially the roots.

MEDICINAL PROPERTIES AND USES:-

Roots are chewed in mouth sores. The plant used to treat indigestion and restore strength after 'Prolonged illness' The dried rhizome is a tonic and act as stomachic. It is administered in intermittent fevers and debility.

CHEMICAL COMPOSITION:-

It contain alkaloids belonging to the Berberine group.

PRODUCTION TECHNOLOGY:-

Cultivated in moist to wed, humus-rich, slightly acid soil in shade. Propagated by seed sown when ripe, by division in spring, roots are lifted in autumn and used fresh or dried in decoctions.
