FAMILY :- Zingiberaceae

LOCAL NAME :- Bat piat

HINDI NAME :- Kebuka, kebu

# **HABITS AND HABITATS:**

Herb, found in Assam, Khasi and Jaintia hills, sub-Himalayan tract of Utter Pradesh and Himachal Pradesh and Western Ghats.

# PLANTS DESCRIPTION :-

Height is about 3-4 feet, spirally ascending leaves sub-sessile, spirally arranged, oblong, cuspidate, villous underneath. Flowers large, pure white, flowering in the month of July-September.

# **PARTS USED:**

Rhizomes.

## **MEDICINAL PROPERTIES AND USES:-**

The plant is Astringent, purgative, depurative anti-inflammatory (used in govt, rheumatism, bronchitis, asthma, catarrhal fevers, dysuria, anthelmintic, antivermin, maggoticide and antifungal.

### **CHEMICAL COMPOSITION:-**

Plant contains Saponins dioscin, gracillin, and beta-sitosterol-beta-d-glucoside. All part of the plant contain steroidal sopogenin, diogenin.

# PRODUCTION TECHNOLOGY:-

Cultivated in moist, well-drained, humus-rich, and neutral to acid soil in shade and high humidity. Propagation is sow seed as soon as ripe at 20° C. divide in spring. Leaves, young stems, and rhizomes are collected as required and used fresh, often in the form of juice. Rhizomes may also be cooked or dried.
