

MULTIDISCIPLINARY TRAINING PROGRAMME CONDUCTED BY KVK WEST SIANG

Kirankumar Singh explained in detail about the SRI method of rice cultivation through power point presentation and Shri Prasanta Mahanta, Research Associate, NHM interacted with the farmer regarding fish farming and importance of fish for generating higher income.
