About Assam

RRC, AICRP on FMD, Guwahati was established on 01st April 1973 under the aegis of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research. Since its inception, RRC, Guwahati has strived hard for providing base line epidemiological data of FMD for planning the strategy of disease control programme. The centre is located at Deptt. of Microbiology, C.V.Sc., AAU, Khanapara, Guwahati-781022 with state-of-the-art laboratories for understanding the epidemiological survey of FMD in NE Region. RRC, Guwahati has Five Network units in Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh and Tripura. In addition, RRC Guwahati has been reporting the FMD outbreaks & control programme in Meghalaya and Sikkim. Presently RRC, Guwahati has also running the PDFMD-PDADMAS collaborative network project on assessment of Socio-economic impact of FMD & its control in India and ICAR funded Tribal Sub Plan Project.



Khanapara, the venue of the meeting is approximately 12 Km from Guwahati railway station and 30

Km from LGBI Airport by road. Provision of prepaid/shared Taxi facilities is available just outside the Airport which usually takes 1 - 1.5 hrs to reach Khanapara costing about Rs. 500/head.
