

Orientation Training Programme of KVKs SMS and Programme Assistants to be held in
ICAR RC for NEH Region, Umiam

ICAR RC for NEH Region is organizing a seven days orientation training under Human Resource Development Programme from 27th August to 2nd September 2016 for the newly joined Subject Matter Specialist (SMS) and Programme Assistant of the KVKs working under ICAR RC for NEH Region. The training programme aims to develop skill and knowledge in implementation of KVK mandates in the farmers' perspective as well in a holistic manner. Emphasis will be given on the methodology of prioritization of problems, development of action plan as well as implementation, which are matching with KVK mandates. The training will also impart knowledge on the new advancement in extension research, front-line extension, programme monitoring and implementation. The inaugural session to be held on 27th August will be chaired by Dr. S.V. Ngachan, Director, ICAR RC for NEH Region, Umiam and graced by Guest of Honour, B.C. Deka, Director, ICAR-ATARI, Zone-III, Umiam and Chief Guest, Dr.K.M. Bujarbaruah, VC, AAU, Jorhat. The seven days training will include lectures by Dr. A.K. Singh, D.D.G. (Agril. Extn.), ICAR, New Delhi and Dr. P. Das, Former D.D.G.(Agril. Extn.), ICAR, New Delhi, as well as lectures and practical sessions by experts from ICAR RC for NEH Region. The trainees will also have field visits and other exercises which will give them a first hand experience with the use of different extension techniques like PRA (Participatory Rural Appraisal). The programme will conclude on 2nd September 2016 with a group exercise to develop the action plan.
