BACK GROUND

North Eastern region of India is one of the biodiversity rich region and abundant in natural resources. However, agriculture farming is still practised at subsistence level, mainly due to climatic and geographical condition of the region and therefore, North Eastern Region is still lagging behind in terms of production and productivity of agriculture and allied sectors compared to rest of India. Also, there are vast opportunities present in the area of entrepreneurship through skill development in agriculture particularly in post harvesting technology, commercial production of mushroom, horticultural crop, piggery and poultry production. Technological intervention for doubling farm income through diversified agriculture, horticulture and animal husbandry including value addition and post harvest management is the need of the hour in the hilly terrain.

ABOUT THE COURSE

The short course will cover topics relevant to agriculture and allied sciences and mainly focus on skill oriented entrepreneurship development and approaches for doubling farmer's income in North Eastern Hill Region. In general there will be lectures and practical demonstration on various aspects of improved technology of agriculture and allied sciences which are adoptable in the hill region.

DURATION

Duration of the short course is 10 days from 27 November to 6 December, 2018 (both days inclusive). The participants are expected to arrive at ICAR Research Complex for NEH Region, Nagaland Centre, Medziphema on evening 26th of November, 2018.

ELIGIBILITY

Participants should be from ICAR Institutes/State AUs/CAU/ Agricultural faculty of AMU, BHU, Vishwa Bharti and Nagaland University in the cadre of Assistant Professors or equivalent and above.

TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

TA/DA will be provided as per ICAR norms. The TA reimbursement will be limited to AC two tier/AC bus by the shortest route (Excluding Rajdhani and Shatabdi). Air travel is not permissible; however travel

by Air India (Booking may be done at Air India or IRCTC websites only) will be reimbursed as per available fare of Indian railway AC two tier. Participants need to produce original ticket for reimbursement. Lodging/boarding for the trainees will be provided by the organizing institute.

HOW TO APPLY?

Eligible and interested participants are requested to apply online through capacity building programme portal (http://cbp.icar.gov.in) only. After login in by the candidate, short course may be selected by clicking apply and fill the necessary required information. Generated application form shall be uploaded after duly recommended/signed by the competent authority of the institute where the candidate is employed. No other mode of application will be entertained. For any other clarification for applying, candidate may contact the co-ordinator by e-mail. The total number of participants shall be limited to 25 only.

The selected candidates will be intimated by e-mail. Cancellation at the last moment for casual reasons after acceptance will be regarded as a serious breach of ethical conduct since it may deprive other eager candidates who could have availed the opportunity.

VENUE AND LOCATION

ICAR Research Complex for NEH Region, Nagaland Centre, Medziphema is located 26 km from the Dimapur railway station and is on the Dimapur - Kohima National Highway (NH 29). Dimapur is well connected with road/rail and air routes. Moreover daily bus and train services are available from Guwahati to Dimapur. Dimapur is also connected with air via Kolkata from major Indian cities by Air India.
