<u>Treatment cum awareness programme on Foot and mouth disease (FMD)</u>

FMD outbreak on Mithun was reported from Metengliang and Bumna village, to control and further spread of disease, KVK Anjaw organized one day Treatment cum awareness camp on Foot and mouth disease (FMD) in collaboration with State Veterinary Dept. Hayuliang at Metengliang primary school, on 4/10/2017. More than 180 mithun was affected from FMD and 30 numbers of Mithun has already succumbed to disease and many more mortality of mithun is expected, as many mithun are still untraceable in jungle, as per field survey report from mithun farmers. Dr. Tilling Tayo SMS Animal Science KVK Anjaw, through power point presentations, briefly thought about how to prevent and control the disease, prior to distribution of medicine to farmer. Dr. G Singh, Sr. Veterinary Officer, Hayuliang Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Spoke on bio-security and vaccination against FMD. Complete package of Medicine viz, Alum, Boric acid powder, Turpentine oil, Analgesic drug, Antibiotic, Tarcoal, Potash, cotton and Hemax spray were distributed to 29 mithun rearing farmers to relive the animal scuffring from FMD and to control further spread of disease. Twenty-tissue sample were collected from affected mithun for virology study and sample will be sent to Disease investigation laboratory, Nirjuli.
