SPECIAL BULLETIN FOR UPCOMING HEAVY RAINFALL IN MIZORAM

- > Harvest all matured panicles after rain will over in case of rice.
- > Don't keep harvested rice bundles in field or cover with plastic.
- Crops like toria, groundnut, greengram and blackgram etc. should be sown immediately after rice harvest with well drainage channel in irrigated medium lands.
- If rice crop in panicle initiation stage apply of cartaf hydrochloride @ 2ml per liter of water when rain will stop and don't apply urea.
- Due to moderate to light rainfall possibility of water logging will be high. So make a channel around the field to drain out the excess water in crop like pea, lentil, Lathyrus, toria, greengram and blackgram.
- Plastic shade must be maintain for tomato, chilli and crucifer vegetablesin nursery stage.
- Possibility of Damping off will be high nursery state so go for any systemic fungicide (Rodomil @2ml/lt of water) spray after rain will over.
- > Reducing water logging by making channel around the field in vegetable crop.
- If crop like tomato, brinjal and chilli in vegetative stage kindly provide support by bamboo stick.
