

Training on 'Package & Practice of kiwi cultivation' held at Chameliang

A one day long training programme on 'Package & Practice of Kiwi Cultivation' was organized by ICAR, KVK Anjaw at Chameliang village under Hayuliang circle on 20th March 2017. Altogether 32 farmers (both men and women) from Chameliang, Rittiliang, Hayugam, Phillang and Barafu villages attended the training programme. Dr. Senpon Ngomle, SMS Plant Pathology welcomed the participants and briefed the gathering about the importance of organizing this training and also highlighted the role of Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) in Agri. and allied field.

The Course Co-ordinator Ms Rebecca Eko, SMS Horticulture gave a detail presentation on the package and practices of Kiwi fruit cultivation. She emphasized on its importance, uses and it's potential to be the next promising fruit crop of Anjaw district. Kiwi fruit has been introduced very recently in this part of the region, so farmers had very little knowledge about its cultivation. Hence, proper power-point presentation and flex was displayed for easy understanding. In the end of the training, Kiwi planting materials were distributed under BADP Scheme on 'Plantation of Kiwi fruit under Hayuliang-Goiliang circle'.
